ctcLink ID number

In ctcLink, every student and employee will get a new ID number, called the ctcLink ID. The ctcLink ID replaces the SID, also called the “900 number.”

When you set up your ctcLink account for the first time, the ctcLink ID number only displays once. Don’t forget to write it down and keep it in a safe place!

*Note: students who are enrolled before March 2020 will continue to manage their financial aid in the current system through the end of June 2020. All students will manage their financial aid in the new system starting in 2020-21.

Class Full? Get on the Waitlist!

Students may be added to the waitlist through the end of the day, Friday, April 3. If openings occur through the third day of the quarter (April 8), you'll be automatically moved from the waitlist into the class. Only students on the waitlist may fill open seats.

Being on the waitlist does not guarantee that you'll get in, or that a new section will be made available. Tuition and fee charges will not include waitlisted classes until you are registered in them. Please stop by the Registration office to remove yourself from a waitlist if you are no longer interested in being enrolled in a class. Evening classes meeting once a week will take their final exam at the regular class time during finals week. Evening classes meeting more than once a week will take the final exam at the regular class time on whichever day during finals week the class agrees upon.

Students enrolled in online courses (DE section) are to contact their instructor for final exam information.

Students are not required to take final exams for more than two classes on a single day. If such a conflict arises, students are to contact their instructor to discuss alternative options. If no solution is determined after the initial meeting with the instructor, students may then petition the appropriate division dean. Arrangements must be made by the end of the 8th week of instruction. For assistance please contact the Office of Instruction by calling 360.442.2550. *Exam priorities shall be based on class meeting day order first, then meeting time.*

Final exams will be administered on the day designated on the final exam schedule. If a deviation from the scheduled day is desired, faculty must seek approval from the appropriate division dean. Time changes, unanimously approved by the class, are acceptable.

For any classes that conflict with other final exams please talk to your instructor for more information.

TUITION & FEES

The Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) has legislative authority to set tuition rates. They also set some fees, while other fees are determined at the college level. Basic tuition and fee rates are broken out on a per-credit basis for resident, non-resident, international and veteran students. There are two levels of tuition rates. Lower division rates apply to certificate and associate degree programs. Upper division rates apply to applied bachelor's degrees only. Additional (miscellaneous) fees are described below the tuition rates.


Resident Students

Washington resident students must verify that they have lived in Washington for one year and have established residency in the State of Washington, including US Citizenship, permanent resident status, hold an A, E, G, H, I, K or L visa or have "refugee/asylum" status. If your residency cannot be determined at the time of admission, your tuition and fees will be calculated at the non-resident tuition and fee rate. Ask about residency at the Registration Office, 360.442.2370. Complete residency rules are detailed in RCW 28B.15.012.

Even if you are not a permanent resident or US Citizen, you may still qualify to pay in state tuition if you have:

- Resided in Washington state for the three (3) years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma, and completed the full senior year at a Washington high school, OR completed the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED) and resided in Washington state for the three (3) years immediately before receiving the equivalent of the diploma; and
- Continuously resided in the State since earning the high school diploma or its equivalent.

If you are eligible, complete the HB 1079 affidavit (Washington Higher Education Affidavit/Declaration/Certification form), available in the Registration office in the Admission Center. The original should be submitted to the LCC Registration office. Contact the Registrar at 360.442.2372 for additional information.

PAYING FOR COLLEGE

Financial Aid

There are two different application forms for financial aid. The **FAFSA** is for U.S. citizens and permanent residents of the U.S. The **WAFSA** is for people who are ineligible for federal financial aid due to immigration status.

Basic Food, Employment & Training (BFET)

Students who are eligible for federal basic food benefits may be eligible for BFET support.

Opportunity Grant

Unemployed or underemployed adults seeking a certificate or degree in a high demand career field may be eligible for an Opportunity Grant.

Scholarships

LCC awards over \$250,000 in scholarships every year. All scholarships are different, and many are not dependent on income eligibility. Scholarships cover tuition, student fees, books and supplies. Some scholarships also cover other expenses like transportation or childcare. The scholarship application period is usually open from early February to early April.

Veterans' Services




ONLINE LEARNING @ LCC

Cooperative Education

LCC's Cooperative Education Program enables students to earn college credit through supervised, work-based learning experience.

This program integrates theories, concepts and methods studied in the classroom with practical skills gained in the workplace. Students may earn one credit for every 33 hours of approved work experience. There is a limit of 1-5 credits per quarter, depending upon specific degree requirements.







Lower Columbia College is converting to a new computer system, called ctcLink, on **March 9, 2020**.

Many things will change with the new system, including how to register for classes. **The 4-digit number you use to register for classes will change at that time.**
