Current Students – How to Register

- Visit the ctcLink mobile website at wa130.ctclink.us. Select the ctcLink Login tile and login using your ctcLink ID number and password. Once you are logged in, you will see the ctcLink mobile dashboard.
- Find out your earliest registration date/ time by selecting Enrollment from the left navigation list, then select the Enrollment Dates option. Choose a quarter, if more than one is displayed.
- 3. Communicate with your program advisor to review your academic plan and plan your class schedule. To find your advisor's information, log into ctcLink. Select Enrollment from the left navigation list, then select Advisor Information. If an advisor has been assigned to you, their information will be displayed here. You can email your advisor by selecting the envelope icon.
- 4. Register for classes online in ctcLink. From the ctcLink mobile dashboard, select Class Information from the left menu and then select Class Search. Enter search criteria, select a class section and then select Enroll. Students taking more than 18 credits must contact Registration for assistance.
- 5. Pay your tuition and fees by the deadline listed on the Academic Calendar online. You may pay online with a credit or debit card using ctcLink. From the ctcLink mobile dashboard, select the Financials icon from the sidebar menu, select What I Owe, then select Make a Payment. 

Human Anatomy/Physiology Instructor Lucas Myers Wins National Award

Biology instructor and head women's basketball coach, Lucas Myers, was named a 2021 Educator of the Year by Instructure, the parent company that provides LCC's online Learning Management System, Canvas. Lucas, who received the award in the "Professor" category, was recognized for his dedication to preparing students for the workforce, promoting academic success and achievement in an evolving educational landscape, and embracing technology in the classroom in new and exciting ways.



In addition to helping redefine how science is taught at LCC, Lucas also provides leadership across the entire Washington community and technical college system for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) educators. Because he began developing fully online biology, human anatomy, and physiology courses long before the pandemic, he was well positioned to succeed when the COVID-19 virus forced a massive switch to online education.

His innovative teaching and assessment practices have also helped to increase the success rate of the college's pre-nursing students, who score 15-20% higher on national human anatomy/physiology exams than average.


Courtney credits her experience as a community college instructor for helping prepare her for success on the game show, along with her own education, expertise in history, and love of trivia.




