LCC Foundation names David and Nadine Coburn 2023-24 Benefactors of the Year

The Lower Columbia College Foundation has named David and Nadine Coburn as the 2023-24 Benefactors of the Year. Benefactor honorees have a history of providing charitable financial support to the foundation, and/or significant volunteer service to the college. Most notably, contributions from honorees have had major impacts on the college, its programs, students, and the community.

"It is with great pleasure that we announce and honor David and Nadine Coburn as this year's Lower Columbia College Benefactors of the Year," said Steve Fuller, LCC Foundation Board Chair.

Nadine grew up on a local dairy farm owned by her parents, Carol and Clayton Greer. Her mother worked for LCC's Dean of Students. Nadine graduated from R.A. Long High School in 1960 and with the help of the PTA scholarship, began attending LCC, a local and affordable college, in the fall. While attending, she worked in LCC's main office as a secretary of student records to help offset the cost of her education. After graduating from LCC in 1962, Nadine transferred to the University of Washington where she earned her teaching degree and met her future husband, David. They married in 1963.

After graduation from the University of Washington, David, who was raised in South Africa, joined the Air Force. During David's time overseas, Nadine returned to Longview and worked as a substitute teacher. They eventually settled in California, where David's successful career as an accountant led him to become a partner in the Arthur Andersen CPA firm where he stayed for more than 45 years. Nadine became a stay-at-home mom to their three sons Greg, Mark, and Steven. David's career allowed them the freedom to travel to 86 countries, including Africa.

Although Nadine and David have lived in California for most of their adult lives and are now enjoying retirement there, their connection to LCC remains strong. They have

continued to support LCC for more than 27 years through their family scholarship, the Carol and Clayton Greer Memorial Nursing Scholarship, established in 1985 in memory of Nadine's father. After her parent's passing, Nadine and David felt privileged to continue the scholarship and have provided more than \$80,000.

David and Nadine both enjoy receiving and writing letters to their student scholarship recipients.

Supporting the college is a source of great pleasure for David and Nadine. They are impressed with the diversity of student recipients, and heart-warmed by their stories. "Being raised in a community with limited opportunities for many of its residents, LCC offers a path upward," said Nadine. LCC provided the stepping stone that made her educational goals a reality, and led her to meet David.

Nadine's parents supported her pursuit of a college education, and told her from an early age that it was "in their plan for me to graduate from college, no ifs, ands or buts!" said Nadine. After she was finished with school, they told her they could finally afford to send her. "Wouldn't they be astounded, to learn that since 1986 their legacy scholarship has helped send more than 43 students to college?" she said.

David and Nadine will be honored at a Foundation Celebration in Fall 2024. "We appreciate this opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate Nadine and David for their ongoing commitment to education at LCC," said LCC President Matt Seimears.

"In the spirit of gratitude, it is with great honor that we plan to dedicate the John and Cathy Natt Plaza," said LCC President, Chris Bailey.

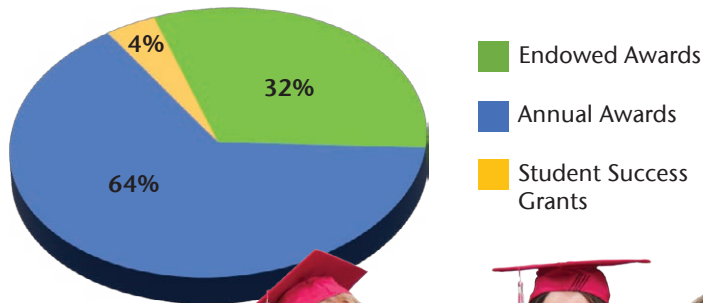
LCC Administration Building Exterior Refresh

Student Support

2022-23 Total Student Support \$566,291



Students are awarded more than \$566,000 each year through the LCC Foundation. In 2022-23, the foundation provided \$1.35 million in support to the college. Nearly 42% was direct student support.



Student Success Fund

The Student Success Fund works! Student Success Fund recipients are completing their degree at a higher rate than that of all LCC students.

The Student Success Fund provides emergency grants to LCC students who are most at-risk for abandoning higher education goals due to financial hardships.

Since 2012, the fund has provided nearly \$620,000 in emergency grants to 1,010 students. The average award is approximately \$614. For many students, this grant means the difference between completing their education or dropping out.

The Student Success Fund helps students with:

- Tuition expenses not covered by financial aid, scholarships, or other grants
- Emergency childcare expenses
- Emergency transportation
- Emergency housing and heating costs
- Tools and other school supplies
- Testing fees



A special thanks to our community partner, *The Daily News*, for their continued support through the Students in Need campaign. Last year, "Students in Need" raised nearly \$40,000 for the Student Success Fund.

Red Devils Excel

The Lower Columbia College athletic program has a long history of success in competition and in the classroom.

You can add some more proof to that legacy.

The LCC Athletic Department was recently honored with the NWAC Conference Presidents Cup for the 2022-23 school year. The Cup is given to the school which has the top achievement in criteria such as grade point average (GPA), completion, and graduation rate. It's the second consecutive Presidents Cup awarded to Lower Columbia. The Devils won the Cup in 2019. Because of Covid-19 and all of the restrictions from the pandemic, the competition was suspended for three years.

In a testament to the overall winning mission for LCC, the Red Devils also won the 2022-23 Athletic Directors Cup for overall on field/court performance. The AD Cup is given to the school that tallies the most points using division finishes and NWAC championship finishes. The Devils won West Region titles in women's soccer,

volleyball, men's basketball, and baseball. The 2023 LCC baseball team won LCC's 15th NWAC championship. All six Red Devil sports teams made the playoffs in 2022-23.

Lower Columbia is the only school in NWAC history to win an Athletic Directors Cup and a Presidents Cup in the same school year. And they have now done it twice.

"I can't tell you how proud I am of our student/athletes," said Lower Columbia athletic director Kirc Roland. "To win the two highest honors in a 35-school conference just shows that our focus on academics and competition can go together."

NWAC Executive Director Marco Azurdia made the Presidents Cup announcements. "LCC continues to show excellence on the field, on the court and also in the classroom. For the NWAC, the Lower Columbia College Red Devils are a legitimate example of what we strive to promote: that being a student and being an athlete are synonymous and you can be successful at both," he said.



Ms. Jeane Wirkkala Moksness Named 2023 LCC Alumna of the Year

The Lower Columbia College Foundation selected Ms. Jeane Wirkkala Moksness as the 2023 LCC Alumna of the Year.

Jeane grew up in Deep River, Washington and after graduating from Naselle High School she moved with her sister to an apartment in Longview with three other young women, in order to attend Lower Columbia College. While attending LCC in 1956, Jeane played on LCC's inaugural women's basketball team, which went undefeated in their first year. After graduating from LCC, she continued her education at Portland State University earning her Bachelor of Science in education followed by obtaining a Master of Education from University of Oregon.

Jeane's professional career included teaching young children from early childhood through second grade in Massachusetts, Oregon, and Washington including 23 years at LCC. She retired from LCC in 2000. During her tenure at LCC, Jeane worked in Early Childhood Education where she served in various roles including instructor/coordinator, Department Chair of Early Childhood and Parent Education, Nursing and Physical Education, and as director of the LCC Childcare Center.

Jeane and her husband, Roger, moved to Longview in 1969 where they raised their three daughters, Joelle, Janae, and Jami.

"LCC provided me a great foundation for my education and career. My career at LCC allowed me to meet wonderful people. LCC is unique in that the faculty bring high quality and consistency. The campus is up-to-date, beautiful, and everything is close and accessible for students."

Jeane's philanthropic support at LCC includes the Athletic Excellence Fund, College Success Fund, Student Success Fund, LCC's Early Learning Center, the Roger and Jeane (Wirkkala) Moksness Endowed Scholarship Fund, the LCCF general scholarship fund, and unrestricted. Jeane's support to the mission of the college is strengthened by her time spent working with students, which allowed her to see the needs of the community first hand and through her service on the LCC Scholarship Committee, reading student applications.

Jeane was honored at the "Lifetime Donor Celebration" on November 14, 2023.

LCC Foundation Receives Nearly \$4 Million Gift

The Lower Columbia College Foundation is pleased to announce receipt of \$3.8 million from the Charles "Chuck" L. Klawitter Estate, resulting in the second largest gift in the Foundation's history.

Chuck was born November 27, 1945, in Longview. He grew up in South Kelso and graduated from Kelso High School in 1964. He attended LCC, then graduated from the University of Washington in 1968 with a BS in Chemical Engineering. After receiving his degree, Chuck went to work for Dow Chemical Company in Midland, Michigan. Dow transferred him to Plaquemine, Louisiana where he worked until he retired in 2004 after 36 years. After retiring, Chuck returned to Kelso and became an active fundraiser with the Kelso Lions Club.



"Lower Columbia College was a foundational part of Chuck's education, and he was always appreciative of the opportunities that resulted from his time at the school. It was important to Chuck that after he passed, he invested in the future of the school and students from the Kelso-Longview area through the donation of his estate," said Carla Kneipp, Chuck's niece and executor of his estate.



Community Comes Together to Turf

The Lower Columbia College softball team will no longer have to put in three hours of field work only to see it wash away with a rain shower.

A collaboration between LCC, the LCC Foundation, Kelso Recreation Council, Rose Foundation, Cowlitz County, City of Kelso, Kelso Girls Softball Association, Cheney Foundation, Rotary Club of Kelso, and Kelso High School resulting in substantial upgrades to two of the softball fields at Tam O'Shanter Park is a home run for female youth, high school, and college athletes.

In 2009, Kelso native Dave Heerensperger donated \$150,000 to improve the softball fields at Tam O'Shanter, including upgrades to the grandstands, clubhouse, fencing, and construction of a concession stand. Improvements to the infield and outfield were not included in the 2009 project, however, and rainwater from the upgraded structures soon began pooling in the softball field. Mud

created by the runoff typically lasted well beyond the rainy weather itself, leading to delayed and canceled games as well as deterioration of the infield dirt. In spite of valiant efforts by coaching staff and volunteers to keep things dry, the poor condition of the field rendered it virtually unusable in rainy conditions.

David Mackin, President of the Kelso Girls Softball Association, is enthusiastic about the increased opportunities the upgraded facilities will bring. "The new field will expand opportunities for younger generations to have more playing time in all kinds of weather. This is the first softball field in the area with artificial turf, and we can take a lot of pride in that," he said, adding, "It's all for the girls', that's why we're doing it."

The benefits of the newly upgraded field go well beyond the athletes and their families. "The newly upgraded fields will allow not only LCC to practice and play in Northwest weather conditions, it will also allow both LCC and the

Kelso Girls Softball Association to host tournaments, which brings people and revenue into the community," said Nolan Wheeler, LCC's Vice President of Administration.

"We are grateful for the college and other community members working together to improve our home field with a new artificial turf infield. The new turf will allow us more days of practice outside, as well as more opportunities for home games. While there are already two turfed baseball fields in town, this will be the first turfed softball field in the county," added Traci Fuller, Head Softball Coach, Lower Columbia College.

Plans are underway to construct an on-campus batting facility for LCC softball in the near future, as part of the LCC Foundation's "Opportunity Can't Wait" capital campaign.

LCC Foundation Endowments
