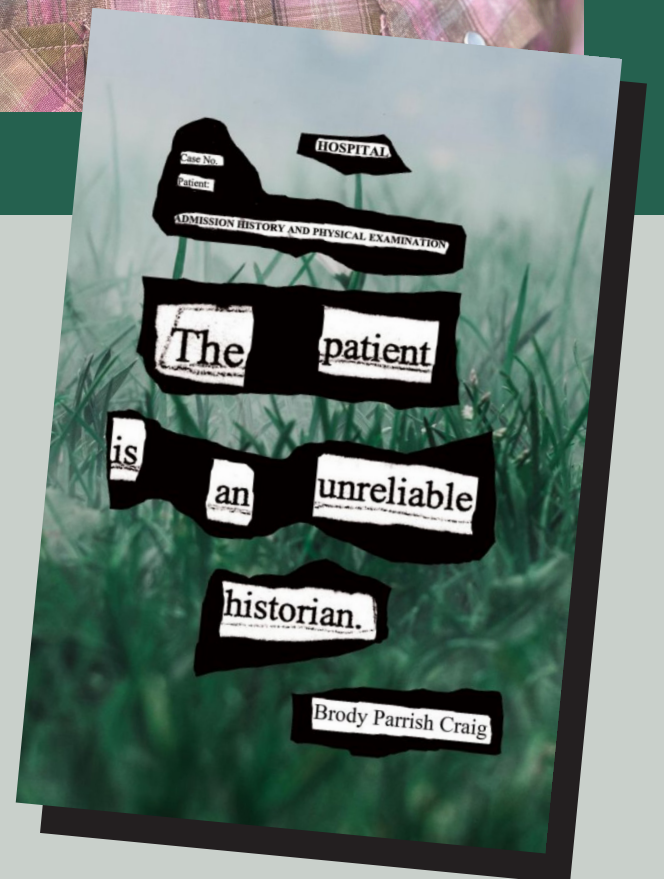

Brody Parrish Craig (they/them) is a southern writer who upheaves expectations to open spaces for connection, unlearning & change. They are the author of *The Patient is an Unreliable Historian* and *Boyish*, the winner of the 2019 Omnidawn Poetry Chapbook Contest. An Arkansas Arts Council Individual Arts Award fellow & two-time Artists 360 awardee, they edited *TWANG*, a regional anthology of trans, nonbinary & gender-non-conforming creators tied to the south/midwest, and facilitated TLGBQ+ community arts programming within Arkansas & beyond until their exile in 2025. They are a graduate of the MFA Program in Creative Writing at University of Arkansas and earned their B.A. from Hollins University. A self-proclaimed “southern trans plant” they currently live in Eugene, Oregon.
