

Following his Honorable Discharge from the Marine Corps in 1969, Nutting spent two years trying to find himself, resulting from what is now known as PTSD. Nutting overcame war-induced troubles, through further education, a marriage, raising three children, and become a business owner. Then he returned to his earlier love of writing and discovered letters he wrote home during his Vietnam tour. Being a natural storyteller, fortified with evidence from these letters, Nutting was able to compose this book with eloquence seldom displayed by most writers. His book, *The Court Martial of Corporal Nutting*, was published in October 2014.
