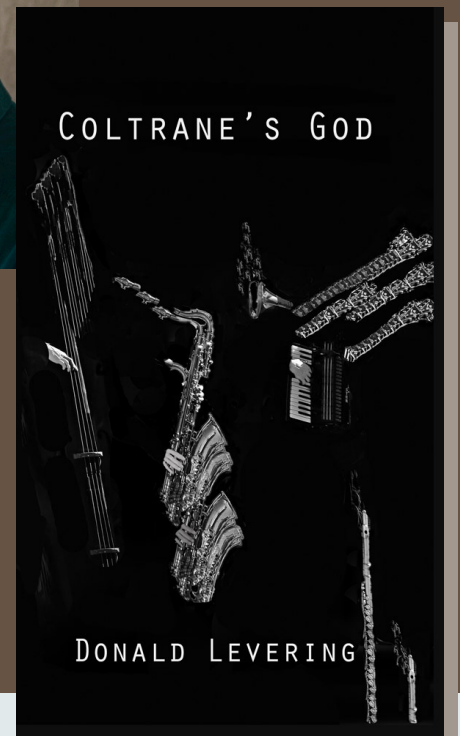


Poets Donald Levering & Joseph Green

Donald Levering was born in Kansas City and grew up there and in Oceanside, New York. In addition to being awarded a NEA Fellowship, he won the Quest for Peace Prize in rhetoric, the 2017 Tor House Foundation Prize and was Runner-Up for the Ruth Stone Prize in 2016. *The Water Leveling with Us*, from Red Mountain Press, placed 2nd in the 2015 National Federation of Press Women Creative Verse Book Competition. His latest book, *Coltrane's God*, was Runner-Up for the 2016 New England Book Festival. He lives in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Joseph Green retired from teaching in 2010, his twenty-fifth year at Lower Columbia College. His poems have appeared in such publications as *The Bellingham Review*, *Cooweescoowee*, *Crab Creek Review*, *5 AM*, *Free Lunch*, *Hubbub*, *Litspeak Dresden* (Germany), *Nimrod*, *Pearl*, *Pontoon*, *Slipstream*, *The Stony Thursday Book* (Ireland), *Terrain.org*, *The Threepenny Review*, *Wilderness*, *Willow Springs*, and *ZYZZYVA*, among others; and two of the poems from his most recent collection, *What Water Does at a Time Like This* were featured on Garrison Keillor's program *The Writer's Almanac*. Together with his wife, Marquita, he produces letterpress-printed poetry broadsides through The Peasandcues Press.
