

2024-25 LOWER COLUMBIA COLLEGE GRANT APPLICATION

If you are currently in financial crisis or have an inability to pay the remainder of your tuition and fees due to financial need, you may be eligible for a Lower Columbia College (LCC) Grant. The LCC Grant only pays tuition and fees, <u>not</u> books and supplies. Due to low availability of funding, we can only award one LCC Grant per student/per year, and we may be unable to fund all student requests.

Per the Washington State Legislature, we are required to give priority to:

- **1st Priority:** Students experiencing an excessively high loan balance that will be difficult to repay given employment opportunities and average starting salaries in their chosen field of study.
- 2nd Priority: Students who are single parents.

If you do not meet either of these priorities, you may still be eligible for funding if available.

To be eligible, you must meet all of the following:

- Complete a 2024-25 FAFSA or WASFA that includes LCC as your school of choice
- Submit all required documents to complete your financial aid file
- Your financial aid status must be in good standing: (Not suspended, in default, or owing a repayment to LCC or a federal/state agency)
- Be a Washington State Resident according to LCC's Registration Office
- Have an unmet financial need according to your FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI), Cost of Attendance (COA), and Financial Aid Awards (COA minus SAI minus Awards = Unmet Need)
- Be registered for at least 3 credits for the quarter
