2. Preference will be given to applicants whose annual family income is below \$100,000.
3. This scholarship award is for \$3,000 for the 2025-26 academic year and may be renewed up for up to (3) three consecutive years if successful academic progress is met, as defined by Altrusa International of Longview-Kelso. Additional information about the renewal process and requirements will be provided in the award letter.
4. Funds will be forwarded to your college or university after Altrusa International of Longview-Kelso has received your acceptance of the scholarship in the first year or your grade report in the second through third years.
