With the start of fall quarter upon us, I am starting to receive more questions about what our status will be for winter quarter.

Right now there are still a lot of uncertainties regarding the pandemic, especially in regard to timelines. Because advanced planning is required for selecting instructional mode (e.g., face-to-face, online, or a combination of the two), the class schedule for winter is going to look a lot like fall.

In addition to the professional/technical programs that resumed some in-person operations in May, we are offering a number of other [on-campus and hybrid classes in the fall](#). We expect the list for winter to be fairly similar. We will continue to evaluate the unfolding situation and may add some additional on-campus options to meet student need.

When we first started remote operations in March, most of us were not expecting the "temporary" situation to last this long. The past several months have been rough. The recent wildfires and related smoke in our area have certainly not made things any easier. Our emergency team remains fully activated, and we will continue to bring back classes and other services and activities as we are able, according to health and safety protocols.
