

LCC: Use of Facilities for Expressive Activities

Groups may use pre-specified locations on Lower Columbia College's campus for expressive activities between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. under the following conditions:

- The expressive activities do not obstruct vehicular, bicycle, pedestrian or other traffic.
- The expressive activities do not interfere with ingress or egress to campus, college buildings, events or activities.
- The expressive activities do not pose hazards or safety risks to the employees, students or other college invitees.
- The expressive activities do not interfere with educational activities.
- The expressive activities do not interfere with the College's mission.
- The expressive activities do not infringe on the College's students' or employees' rights and privileges.
- Sound amplification devices are kept (at) a volume that does not disrupt classroom, office, laboratory or other college activities or events.
- All sites used for expressive activities are clean and left in their original condition after the event.
- All fire, safety and sanitization regulations are obeyed.
- Activities do not include camping, cooking, sleeping, storing of personal belongings or the construction of shelters.
- Activities do not include commercial sales, solicitations, advertising or promotions.
- All activities comply with college, local, state and federal policies and regulations.
- Individuals participating in expressive activities do not bring any firearms, explosives, dangerous chemicals or other dangerous weapons which can be used to inflict bodily harm or to damage real or personal property on the college grounds. *
- Individuals participating in expressive activities do not possess, use or consume alcohol, prohibited drug or tobacco on campus property. **
- Individuals participating in expressive activities are not under the influence of prohibited drugs or alcohol. **
- Expressive activities do not include obscene, lewd or indecent conduct.

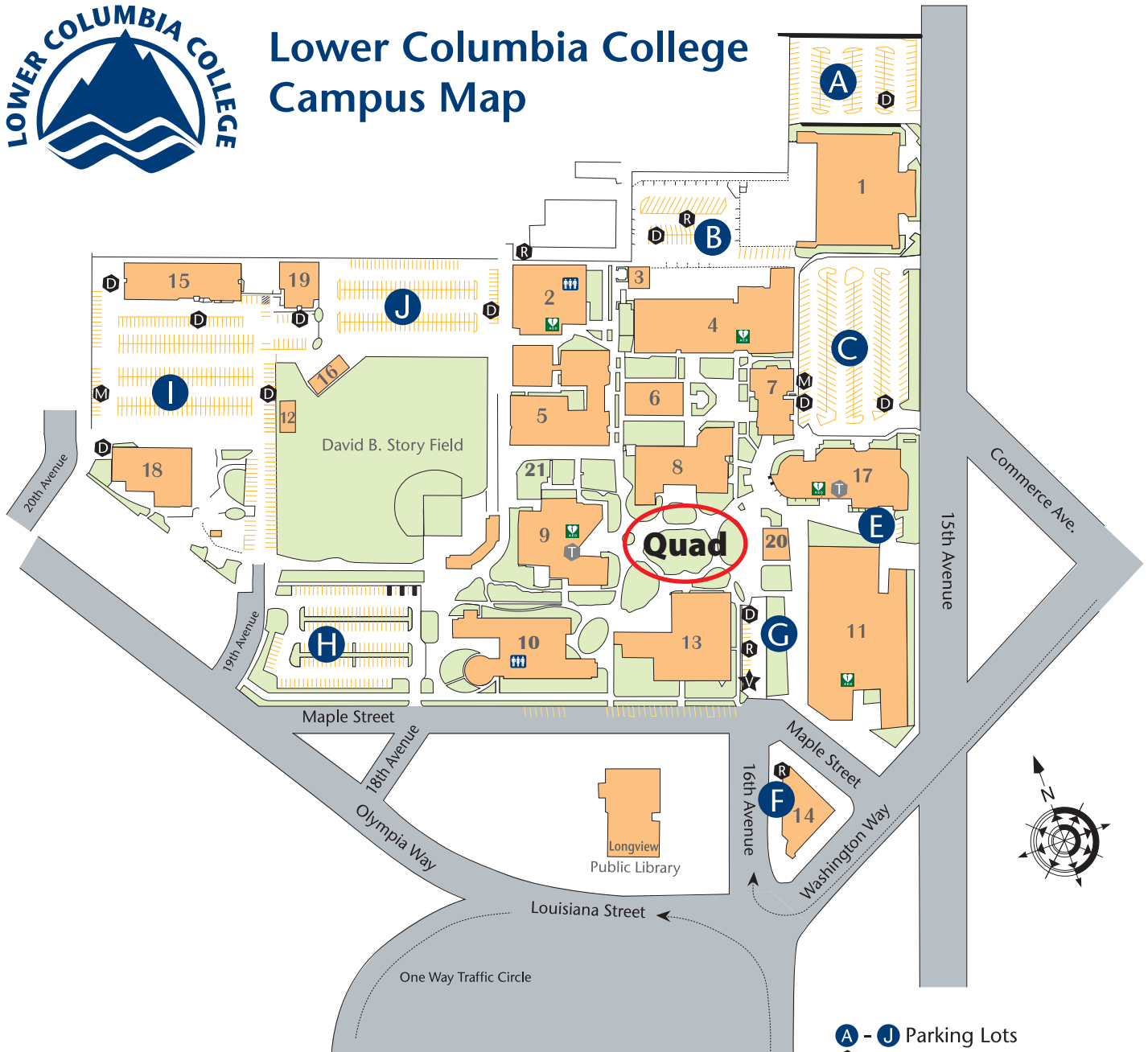

* Weapons carried by duly constituted law enforcement officers are exempt from this policy (WAC 132-M-125-035(8) (LCC Campus Policy 246).

** Prohibited drugs include those defined in chapter 69.41 RCW, or any other controlled substance under chapter 69.50 RCW, except as prescribed for use by the individual by a licensed practitioner.
