You may have heard Governor Inslee's Declaration of an Emergency to close K-12 public and private schools in Washington through April 24. You will receive additional information as it becomes available. In the meantime, here is some time sensitive information:

Childcare needs: Contact your instructors if you experience any emergency childcare issues impacting your ability to take your finals.

Campus operations: Essential services will remain open, as staffing is available. More specific information will follow later.

Spring quarter: Your faculty will communicate with you about the delivery of spring quarter classes.

ctcLink account activation: LCC plans to invite students to activate their ctcLink accounts on March 23. Spring quarter registration (adding/dropping classes) will be available at that time.
