- * COVID-Like Illness (CLI) Symptoms:
- Fever
 - Chills
 - Cough
 - Fatigue
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Diarrhea
 - Loss of sense of taste/smell
 - Shortness of breath
 - Muscle/body aches
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting

Close Contact:

Coming within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes, starting from 2 days before illness onset or positive test results (for asymptomatic patients) until patient is isolated.

Does not apply to healthcare workers caring for patients known

- **Do Not Quarantine If (all 3 must be true):
- It has been 2+ weeks since you completed a vaccine series
 - It has been less than 3 months since you completed a vaccine series
 - You do not have any CLI symptoms
- Note: International travelers must still follow travel requirements.
