

# Return to Campus Guide for Childcare

## \* CLI Symptoms w/ No Exposure to a Confirmed Case

- Stay home
- See your healthcare provider
- Telework if possible

1. Return to work w/ doctor's note, OR
2. After 48 hours symptom-free, **AND** 10 days post symptom onset.

## \* Close Contact w/ Someone w/ CLI Symptoms

- Stay home
- See your healthcare provider
- Telework if possible

1. Quarantine 48 hrs, OR
2. If contact is ongoing, quarantine for 48 hrs AFTER the person is symptom-free

## Close Contact w/ Person Being Tested

- Stay home
- See your healthcare provider
- Telework if possible

- Quarantine until the Close Contact receives test results

Does not apply to contact with workers who are randomly tested

## Close Contact w/ A Confirmed Case

- Stay home
- See your healthcare provider
- Telework if possible

- Quarantine for 14 days after exposure

## Diagnosed w/ COVID-19

- Stay Home
- Telework if possible

- Isolate according to Dept. of Health (minimum 10 days)

## \* COVID-Like Illness (CLI) Symptoms:

- Fever
- Chills
- Cough
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Diarrhea
- Loss of sense of taste/smell
- Shortness of breath
- Muscle/body aches
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting

## Close Contact:

Coming within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes, starting from 2 days before illness onset or positive test results (for asymptomatic patients) until patient is isolated.

Does not apply to healthcare workers caring for patients known to have COVID-19.
