Dr. Orchard will ensure that this process is approved by students next year before it goes to the Board of Trustees. Dr. Orchard stated that beginning the new fee schedule for Winter Quarter is an option. Lily James recommended beginning the new fee schedule with Winter Quarter registrations. Cameron Campbell moved to approve this change in schedule and Tom Holtslander seconded the motion. All were in favor, none were opposed, and none abstained. The motion passed unanimously.
