

Academic Standing Flowchart Outline

Top of chart begins: Academic Standing - Assessed each quarter.

1. If “Quarterly and cumulative GPA at least 2.0,” then “Good Standing”
2. If “Quarterly GPA below a 2.0,” then “Academic Warning”
 - a. If “Academic Warning” and “Quarterly GPA 2.0, though cumulative is still below a 2.0,” then “Academic Warning Improved” and return to “Academic Warning”
 - b. If “Academic Warning” and “Quarterly and Cumulative GPA at least 2.0,” then “Good Standing”
 - c. If “Academic Warning” and “Quarterly GPA below a 2.0,” then “Academic Probation”
 - i. If “Academic Probation” then “Quarterly GPA 2.0, though cumulative is still below,” then “Academic Probation Continued” and return to “Academic Probation”
 - ii. If “Academic Probation” then “Quarterly and cumulative GPA at least 2.0,” then “Good Standing”
 - iii. If “Academic Probation” then “Quarterly GPA below a 2.0,” then “Academic Suspension”
 1. If “Academic Suspension,” then “Suspended for two quarters. Petition for reinstatement,” then return to “Academic Probation”
